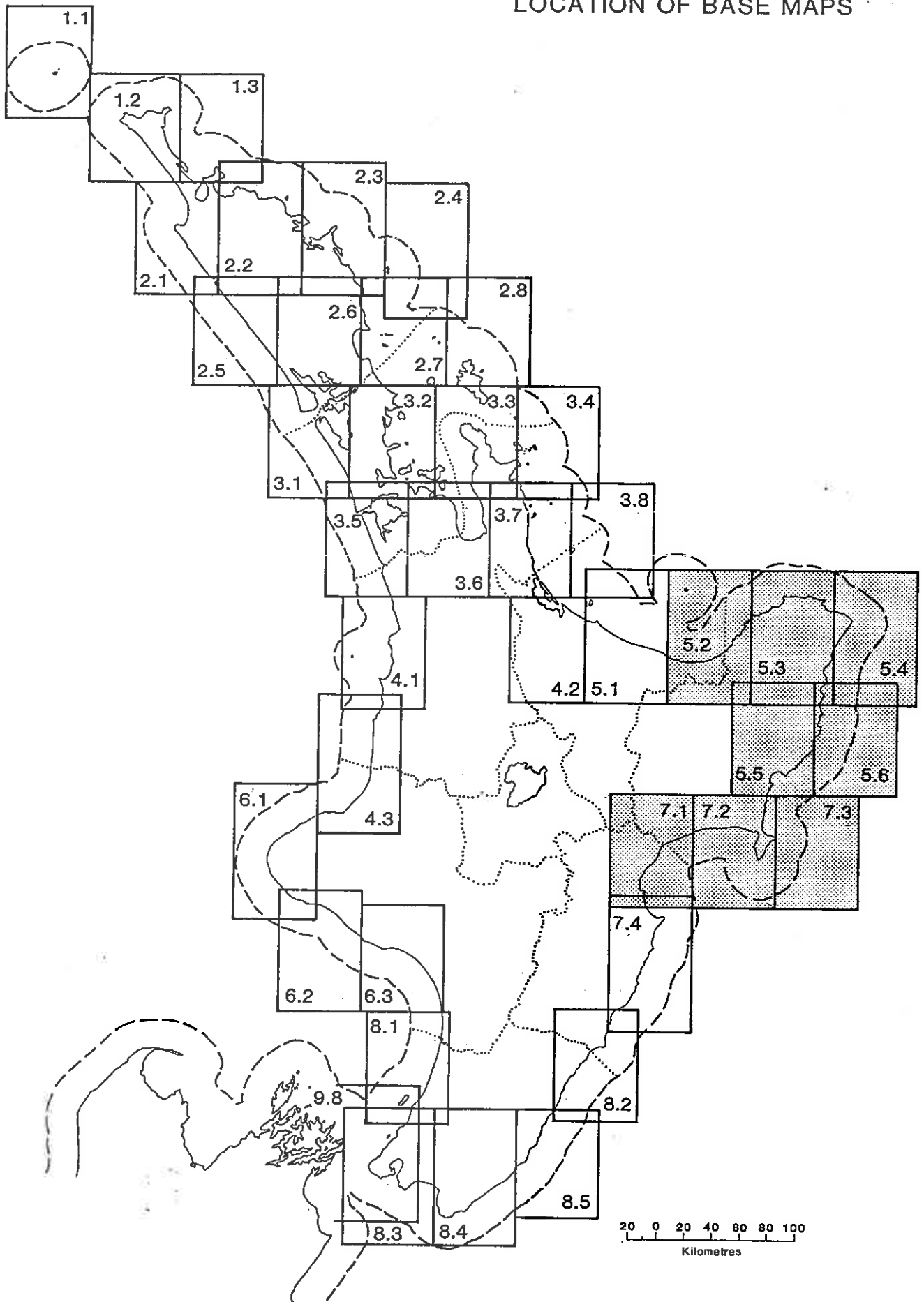
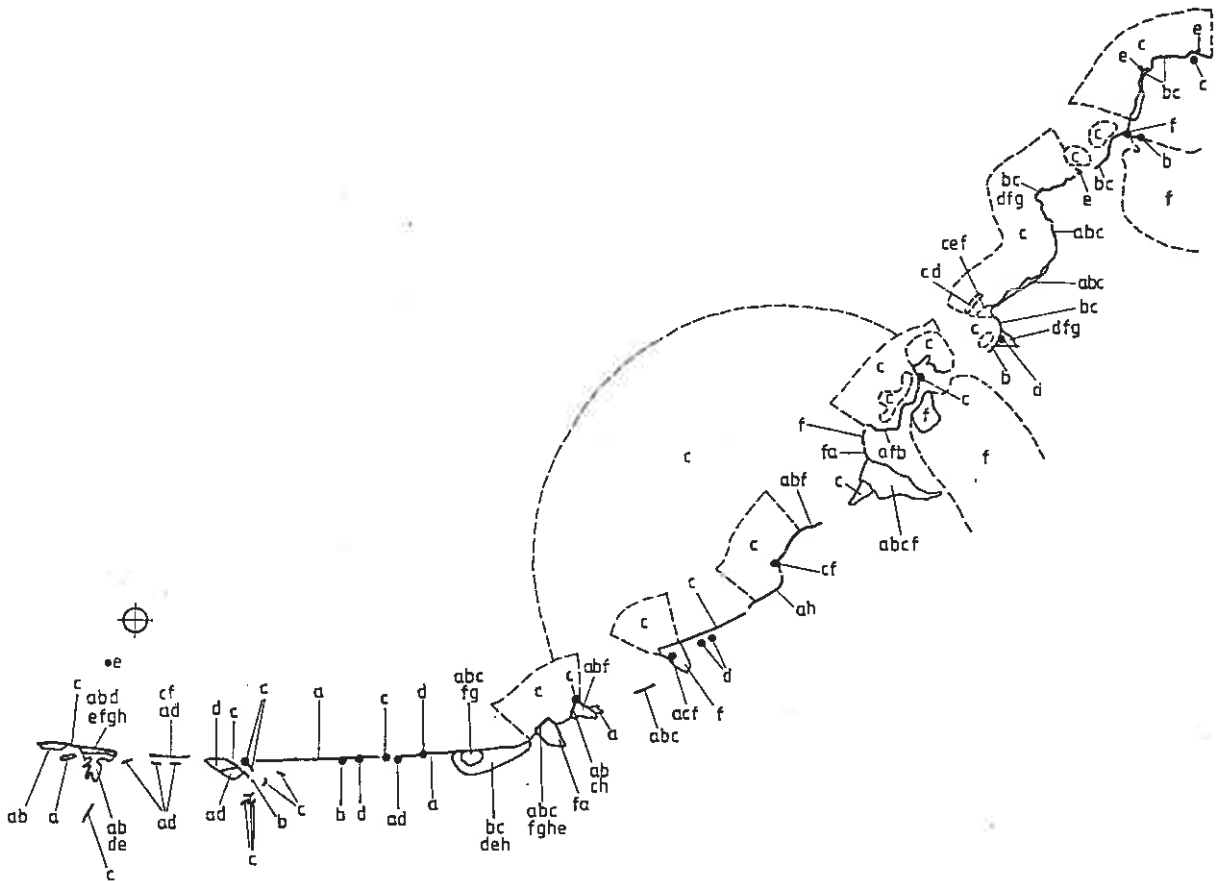

LOCATION OF BASE MAPS



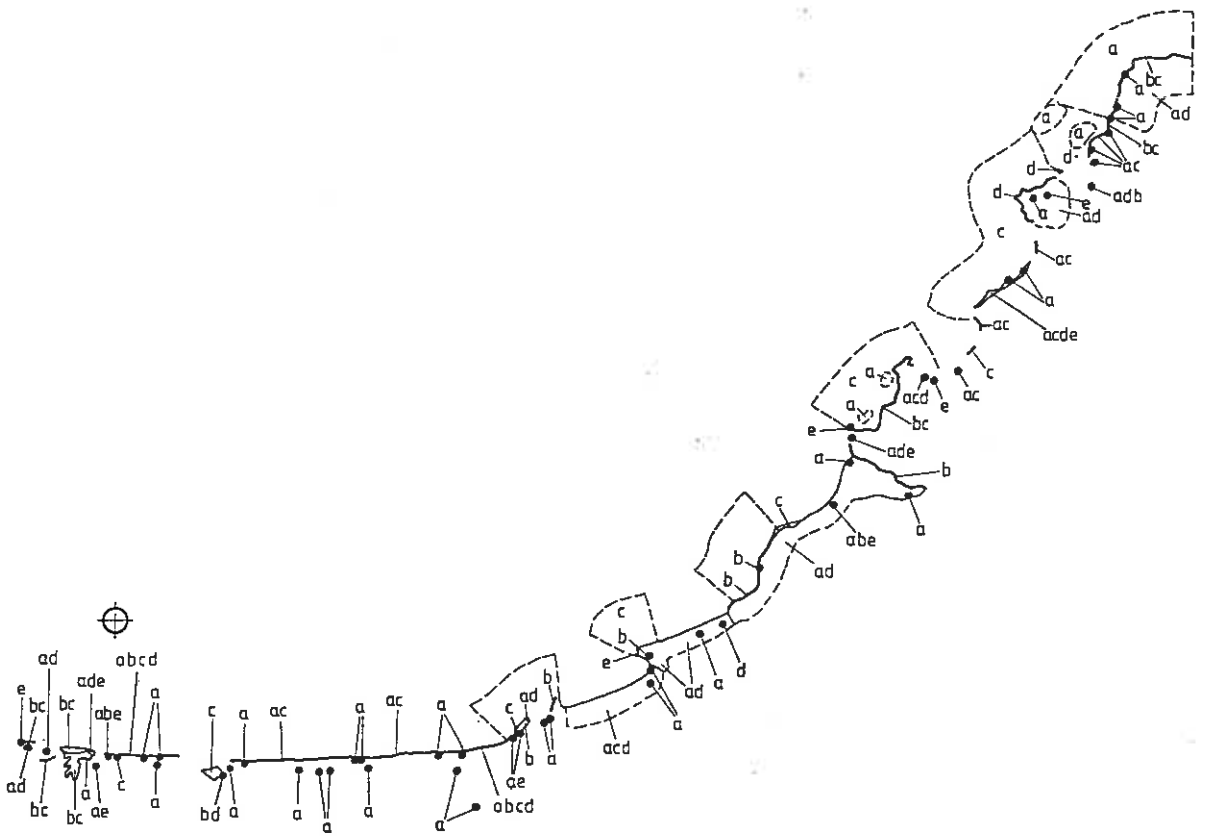
