**List of vascular plants for Tangimoana dunes¹,
just south of Rangitikei River mouth.**

(¹ mostly Tawhirihoe Scientific Reserve, but also includes site of old rubbish dump)

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Last amended 29 Jan. 2001

Nationally threatened and uncommon species (de Lange *et al.* 1999): **CRITICAL** *Pimelea* "Turakina" (transplanted here); **VULNERABLE** *Selliera rotundifolia*, *Isolepis basilaris*; **DECLINING** *Eleocharis neozelandica*, *Pimelea arenaria* "southern form", **RECOVERING** *Desmoschoenus spiralis*.
